

The school offer for those pupils who have additional needs and are learning remotely



School will:

- Provide high quality teaching to ensure that all teaching is accessible for learners.
- Look at each pupil's individual profile and consider what this means for remote learning in the context of their subject and the curriculum they're covering.
- Use learning passports and the SEND register to ensure there is a full understanding of the need of each pupil.
- Talk to the family, and the pupil themselves if appropriate, about the set-up for study they have at home.
- Send home any physical resources that support the pupil in school.
- Prioritise regular contact with someone from school such as a key adult, to maintain positive relationships.
- Continue to hold annual reviews for those pupils who have an Education Health and Care Plan (EHCP).
- Where necessary, update risk assessments for those who have an EHCP and regularly review them.
- Provide specialist intervention during form time or after school that delivers a personalised programme tailored to specific needs.
- Continue to work with outside agencies to ensure additional support is in place where needed.
