Students will develop skills on how to revise languages and will build confidence revising the key aspects of theme 1,2 and 3 revision.  Write in three time frames confidently applying prior knowledge to ensure they can communicate effectively.
<b>Links to prior learning:</b>	Throughout this half term the students will be revising themes 1, 2 and 3 which was taught at throughout the GCSE course. There will be some gaps in knowledge due to the uptake of home learning during Covid-19 disruptions.

<b>Week 1:</b> <b>12.04.2021</b>	Theme 3 revision focusing on my studies, school and opinions vocabulary. Students will revise key concepts and will demonstrate knowledge using Application of knowledge tasks covering all three skill areas.
<b>Week 2:</b> <b>19.04.2021</b>	Theme 2 revision focusing on Environment and social issues vocabulary. Students will revise key concepts and will demonstrate knowledge using Application of knowledge tasks covering all three skill areas.
<b>Week 3:</b> <b>26.04.2021</b>	Formal assessment week completing full exam papers for Reading, Listening and Writing.
<b>Week 4:</b> <b>03.05.2021</b>	Theme 1 revision focusing on food, eating out, shopping and customs and festivals. Students will revise key concepts and will demonstrate knowledge using Application of knowledge tasks covering all three skill areas.
<b>Week 5:</b> <b>10.05.2021</b>	Theme 3 revision focusing on future plans and jobs vocabulary. Students will revise key concepts and will demonstrate knowledge using Application of knowledge tasks covering all three skill areas.
<b>Week 6</b> <b>17.05.2021</b>	Theme 2 Revision focusing on holiday vocabulary. Students will revise key concepts and will demonstrate knowledge using Application of knowledge tasks covering all three skill areas.
<b>Week 7</b> <b>24.05.2021</b>	Theme 1 Revision focusing on free time, family and relationships vocabulary. Students will revise key concepts and will demonstrate knowledge using Application of knowledge tasks covering all three skill areas.
