Westborough continues to adopt a blended approach to remote education in the ever changing circumstances caused by the pandemic. The remote learning offer includes:

- Live lessons
- Recorded lessons or teacher explanations
- High quality online resources
- Links to online educational websites

What if my child's year group has been asked to learn from home?

- Pupils should follow their usual timetable between the hours of 9am and 3pm and access remote education through Microsoft Teams.
- Where staff are available, pupils will be invited to join their lessons live.
- Where staff are unavailable, remote education will be provided through Microsoft Teams and supported by high quality online resources including:
 - Recorded lessons or teacher explanations
 - High quality online resources
 - Links to online educational websites

What if my child is absent from school for reasons relating to Covid?

- If your child is well enough to engage with remote learning:
 - Pupils should follow their usual timetable between the hours of 9am and 3pm and access remote education through Microsoft Teams.
 - The remote education offered will be a blended provision and include the use of:
 - Live lessons
 - Recorded lessons or teacher explanations
 - High quality online resources
 - Links to online educational websites
- If your child is not well enough to engage with remote learning on the day, it is still essential that they catch up on the work missed. Once they are feeling better, pupils should access catch up work on Microsoft Teams in each of the subject areas affected.
